At Maui Lani Physicians and Surgeons, LLC, serving you is the most important thing we do, and your health, safety and well-being remains our top priority. As the novel coronavirus COVID-19 begins to impact our community and daily lives, we want to assure you that we are monitoring developments very closely and taking action at our office on a daily basis to protect and support our family of patients and employees.

Changes that will be implemented in our office will be put into place immediately and will continue until further notice, unless modifications are deemed necessary.

1. Our Practice is turning in to mostly PATIENT ONLY practice. Only patients and (if necessary in the case of younger patients) one accompanying adult should enter our office. We are also making an exception to have 1 other person in the appointment with you for the following: Appointments to establish pregnancy, your OB physical appointment (2nd appt), if you are scheduled for an ultrasound around 35-36 weeks, Pre-Operative appointments and Surgery Consultation appointments. Otherwise, we kindly ask that your family and friends remain in their vehicles.
2. For patients that are having a procedure that require you to have a driver, we ask that your driver remain in the vehicle until your procedure is complete. A nurse will escort the patient to the vehicle once she is discharged.
3. Patients will be asked to come in for their appointments at their regularly scheduled times and not too early.
4. We are giving our patients ages 65 and over the option to reschedule their appointments to a later date to minimize their exposure, unless deemed urgent.
5. Completing your registration forms online prior to your appointment will help assure that you are seen at your scheduled appointment time. If your forms are not completed, this could delay the time you are seen.

There are signs on our door that state: if you have traveled out of state within 14 days of your appointment, have any symptoms of Fever and/or Coughing or have had contact with anyone that tested positive for COVID-19 OR have traveled out of state and has had fever or coughing, we ask that you return to your vehicle and call us so that we can triage you and then direct you to the nearest testing facility or your PCP if necessary.

Please know that we are committed to taking every measure possible to keep our patients and employees safe and healthy so you will continue to feel comfortable while visiting with us. We will also be communicating with you if and when we have additional updates or information to share.
